Advanced Grades

A pass in an Advanced GCE subject is indicated by one of the five Grades: A(a), B(b), C(c), D(d), E(e), of which A(a) is the highest and E(e) the lowest.

Grade N(n) indicates that the candidate's performance fell short of the standard required for Grade E(e) by a narrow margin.

Advanced Supplementary Grades

A pass in an Advanced Supplementary subject is indicated by one of the five Grades: A(a), B(b), C(c), D(d), E(e), of which A(a) is the highest and E(e) the lowest.

Grade N(n) indicates that the candidate's performance fell short of the standard required for Grade E(e) by a narrow margin.

Examinations in Advanced Supplementary subjects are of the same standard as examinations in Advanced level subjects, but Advanced Supplementary syllabuses cover about half the subject content of Advanced level syllabuses.

Advanced Subsidiary Grades

A pass in an Advanced Subsidiary GCE subject is indicated by one of the five Grades A(a), B(b), C(c), D(d), E(e), of which A(a) is the highest and E(e) is the lowest.

Grade N(n) indicates that the candidate's performance fell short of the standard required for Grade E(e) by a narrow margin.

An Advanced Subsidiary GCE subject represents the first half of an Advanced GCE course of study and is broadly equivalent to a 3-unit Advanced Subsidiary Vocational Certificate of Education subject.

Advanced Extension Awards

A pass in an Advanced Extension Award is indicated as Distinction or Merit, of which Distinction is the higher.
